Rules of Entry

(Entry Form for Photo Fest on Reverse)

A. GENERAL RULES of ENTRY

1. Open to all HAL-PC members and the general public living in the Houston Metro Area.
2. Entry must have been captured/created by entrant.
3. Entry may be submitted to the HAL-PC Clear Lake office before the meeting or may be brought the day of the Photo Fest. PLEASE ARRIVE BY 9:00 IF BRINGING ENTRIES ON EVENT DAY.
4. Entries must be accompanied by basic contact information on an entry form.
5. HAL-PC Clear Lake facilitators will review entries and manage this event, as necessary.
6. Entrant need not be present to display entry.
7. Outstanding entries will be recognized.
8. No cash prizes will be awarded
9. Entry is property of entrant but may be used modestly in promotional efforts at a later date.
10. Entries must be claimed by the Entrant at the end of the Photo Fest. Unclaimed entries will be retained for one week.
11. Entrant is responsible for security of any valuable, personal hardware, software, peripherals, etc. related to their entry.
12. HAL-PC Clear Lake and personnel will be held harmless for any adverse, etc. outcomes as a result of this event.
13. **Entrant accepts all rules upon entering this event, including judgments of facilitators.**

B. PHOTO FEST 2008 RULES

1. Entry must be of digital origin. Scanned items are permissible in the "Before and After" contest category and in Exhibit Only area.
2. No more than one hard copy print may be submitted per entrant per contest category.
3. The maximum dimension of entries submitted in the contest categories is 8 ½ by 11 inches.
4. Entrant must choose a contest category for each hard copy entry.
5. Exhibit Only items will not be voted on. Exhibit entries may include scanned items, and are not limited by size. Up to three entries per exhibit category are permitted.

C. VIDEO FEST 2008 RULES

1. Entry must be digital but may be from an analog source.
2. Entrant must choose a category for each entry: Video or Animation.
3. Entries must show some minimal amount of flow, smoothness and attention to detail.
4. Entry format and media must support the display hardware and software available (e.g., Windows XP Home, projector, DVD player, analog TV; 16x9 formatted videos may letterbox when displayed).
5. Entry duration is not time-limited, and, as such, might not be displayed in its entirety, etc.
6. Entry may be submitted on a desktop or laptop computer, optical disc, or flash drive. No camera, camcorder, VHS tape, web streamed, or unusual file format entries will be accepted.
