

## ABOUT THE ELECTION

**VOTE IN PERSON on JUNE 21, 2014 at HQ**

It is election time again! **BIG CHANGE THIS YEAR! NO ONLINE VOTING. IN-PERSON ONLY! JUST USE YOUR MEMBERSHIP NUMBER!**

The By-laws of HAL-PC require that an Annual Meeting of the members for the purpose of filling any vacancies among the Directors be held in June of each year. **There are ten vacancies on the Board of Directors. Only one person submitted their candidacy, so this is a “no contest” election.** Write-In Candidates previously vetted by the Election Committee will be permitted. See details below.

**IN PERSON VOTING.** Please come to vote at HAL-PC HQ on June 21, 2014 beginning at 1:00 PM, and the polls will close promptly at 3:00 PM. Know your membership number which you will place on your numbered paper ballot. The last person in the line at 3:00 PM will be the last person allowed to vote. The Election Committee will announce the unaudited results as soon thereafter as is practicable.

Please Note: Before you come to HAL-PC to vote, make sure you were a dues-paid member as of June 20, 2014. The Election Committee CANNOT renew your membership on Saturday June 21, 2014.

**WRITE-IN CANDIDATES.** Write-In candidates will be permitted on Election Day June 21, 2014. However, all Write-In Candidates must be previously vetted by the Election Committee. Those persons who wish to be written in on the Ballot may submit their statement of intent to serve on the Board of Directors by emailing [election@hal-pc.org](mailto:election@hal-pc.org). Those candidates will then be vetted by the Election Committee and placed on the ballot. Any ballots containing NON-Vetted Write-In candidates are void, and will not be considered by the Election Committee.

## CANDIDATE CAMPAIGN STATEMENTS

The Candidate's Statements and Ballot positions were determined by the chronological order received. If the candidates submitted statements, no content editing has been performed. Statements are published as submitted, *including misspellings and errors of fact, grammar and punctuation, and errors in the name, spelling, and styling of HAL-PC and HALNet.* The statements have, however, been reviewed for compliance with the statement format published in the Call for Candidate announcements; some statements may be truncated in order to conform to the 250 word limit.

### 1. JIM STORY
