As you have parked in a disabled parking space, but have not displayed your Disability Parking Placard, please complete the following as it applies to you.

- Sorry, I forgot my Disability Parking Placard.
- I'm an idiot & enjoy making disabled people struggle.
- I'm just lazy and couldn't be bothered to walk.
- I want to be disabled and just practicing.
- The voices in my head told me to park here.
- I'm just too important to think about others.
- I'm **not** disabled but I'm shopping for a disabled person.
- I do not understand the English language.
- I have as much right to park here as a disabled person.

1. First offense: \$250-\$500
2. Second offense: \$300-\$600

Who has the authority to investigate violations of Texas parking law?

Additionally, some communities have volunteers who enforce parking laws.
